Madam, Sir,

Oudon, a small historical town in the Loire Valley opened itself to the artistic world when it welcomed the sculptor Jean-Claude Lambert, for 6 weeks, in summer 1996.

For the second symposium French and foreigner artists came to join him.

Then a workshop of introduction to clay modelling and sculpture was created in parallel of this symposium. In 2005, the artistic event considered as essential became a biannual event.

Since 2013, O CAP Association has organized this event.

In 2021, the International Symposium of Monumental Sculptures will take place on the port of Oudon from Sunday August 1 to Sunday August 15.

So during 2 weeks, in front of the public, in a setting pleasant, convivial and favorable to the artistic expression, 5 sculptors will make giant sculptures on the following subject : "**The four elements**".

At the same time, a workshop of clay modelling and sculpture and a workshop of wrought iron will be opened to the public, proposing educational activities.

You are invited to propose your project now, by sending back the file which includes signed Regulation and this registration file signed, Curriculum Vitae, a photo, a drawing or sketches of your project, data Sheet (technical information) with the wishes and the needs of material, a presentation of your approach and your motivations with the title of your project, the photo of your work and you before February 1.2021.

Then the committee will select the best propositions.

We hope you will be selected as a member of the symposium.
